CAMBRIDGE 41, DOVER 35

DOVER -- Cambridge senior tailback Stephen Ford ran 65 times for 412 yards--both school records--and scored two touchdowns to lead the Cambridge Bobcats to a 41-35 win over the Dover Tornadoes. Ford, who set the CHS career rushing record in the win at Indian Valley two weeks ago, broke the previous single-game rushing record of 388 yards set by former career-record holder Darin Ford at Zanesville in 1989. Stephen Ford also eclipsed the 4000-yard mark for his career in the first quarter, and now has 4376 yards for his career.

Cambridge senior quarterback Sean Mahley also had a big game, rushing 15 times for 109 yards and 4 touchdowns--including the game-winner with five seconds remaining in the game, while completing 3 of 5 passes for 66 yards. The Bobcats (6-0, 3-0 ECOL) finished the game with 543 yards rushing and 66 yards passing for 609 yards of total offense.

Dover senior quarterback Perci Garner was a standout for the Tornadoes (5-1, 2-1 ECOL), completing 22 of 37 passes for 387 yards with 2 touchdowns and 1 interception, while also rushing for 2 TDs. Junior wide receiver Matt Rinehart led the Tornadoes with 8 receptions for 195 yards and 2 TDs, while senior WR Daniel Ifft added 8 catches for 129 yards.

With the victory, Cambridge head coach Rick Goodrich (44 wins) became the all-time winningest coach in CHS history, passing Harry Pine.
