CAMBRIDGE 27, MEADOWBROOK 0

CAMBRIDGE -- Senior tailback Stephen Ford ran for 173 yards and two touchdowns, and senior quarterback Sean Mahley ran for 62 yards and two scores as the Cambridge Bobcats won the East Central Ohio League championship and completed the first undefeated season in school history by defeating archrival Meadowbrook, 27-0.

Ford eclipsed the 5000-yard mark for his career, finishing the evening with 5084 yards for his career. He also broke his own single-season rushing record, finishing the night with 1956 yards on the season. The Bobcats (10-0, 7-0 ECOL) will play their first-ever home playoff game next Saturday night--likely against either Canal Fulton Northwest or Tri-Valley.
