CAMBRIDGE -- Senior quarterback Sean Mahley threw for 137 yards and two touchdowns, and added 89 yards on the ground, while senior tailback Stephen Ford ran for 98 yards and two scores as the Cambridge Bobcats won their first playoff game in school history, defeating the Canal Fulton Northwest Indians, 27-14.

Ford eclipsed the 2000-yard rushing mark in the third quarter, extending his own CHS single-season rushing record to 2054 yards. Mahley also achieved a milestone, becoming the first CHS player to pass for 1000 yards in a season since Josh Lowery in 2001.

The Bobcats (11-0) will face ECOL foe Dover (10-1) next Saturday at a site to be determined. Canal Fulton Northwest closes its season with a 6-5 record.
